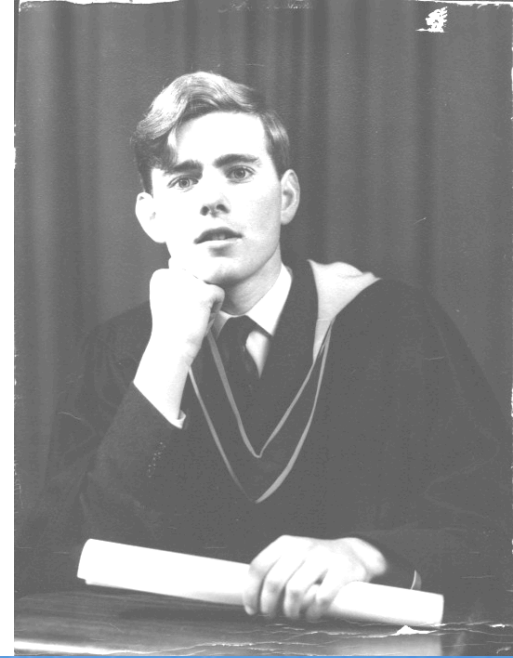

1. Michael D. McCarthy (also known as Donal McCarthy)



- He served as President of UCC from 1967 to 1978. [University College Cork +2](#)
- He was a noted statistician: his biography states he was a “statistician and university administrator”.
- Born 4 June 1908 in Midleton, Co Cork; died 31 January 1980. [University College Cork +1](#)

2. Tadhg Ó Ciardha (also known as Timothy Morgan Carey)



- He served as President of UCC from 1978 to 1988. [University College Cork](#)
- He was Professor of Statistics and in earlier life held the first full-time Professorship of Statistics at UCC in 1952. [University College Cork +1](#)
- Born 14 March 1919, died 1995. [University College Cork](#)

3. Michael A. (Aidan) Moran



- He held the Chair of Statistics at UCC from 1975 until 1989, when he became Registrar. [University College Cork +1](#)
- Although I did not find a clear reference that he served as President of UCC, the data shows strong statistical credentials and a senior leadership role at UCC.
- The user-given name “Aidan Moran” seems to match “Michael A. (Aidan) Moran” in the UCC sources.



Statistician Donal McCarthy (1908-1980) was born 4 Jun in Midleton, Cork. He was educated at UCC, and studied at University College London. The latter led to a PhD, awarded by UCC, where he then taught for a decade. He served as director of the Central Statistics Office, before returning to UCC as president of the college.
